Spring Rubbish Pick-Up Saturday, April 17

All items must be curbside by 7am on this day, but no earlier than **SEVEN (7) DAYS** prior.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- All bagged and containerized municipal solid waste.
- Bags and containers must weigh less than 50 lbs.
- Larger items, such as: Furniture, Mattresses, Box Springs, Toys, Bicycles, Appliances**, Home Fixtures, and other items as long as they are considered Non-Hazardous AND can be safely lifted by two people.
- Latex Paints - Paint must be dried up in containers. (use sawdust, kitty litter or just leaved the paint can open for a few days to dry out the contents). The contents must be solid and dry to be taken.

- No small loose items. Must be a bulk item or in a bag or box/container for collection. Boxes must weigh less than 50 lbs. to be serviced.
- **Appliances that contain Freon, such as Refrigerators & Air Conditioners. *These items can be accepted if the Freon is removed and the appliance is tagged by a licensed facility that the Freon is removed.
- Any additional items that are listed by the Michigan DEQ as banned from Michigan Landfills.

If articles are placed at the curb AFTER your street has been picked up, the crews WILL NOT return to that street.

Any remaining items should be removed from the curbside by 7am the following morning.

Refuse pick-up is for City of Hudson Residents only. A fine will be charged if rubbish from outside of the City is found being brought into the City.

SWIMMING POOLS

- Water level greater than 24 inches and the side walls on the units are LESS than 48-inches and require a permit AND a 48 inch Fence.
- Fence spacing cannot exceed 1.75 inches and MUST have a Self Latching Gate.
- Temporary Pools or portable pools require the same permits with a one time fee.
- A rate adjustment on your water bill may be available for filling a swimming pool.


