LAWN MAINTENANCE

Owners of OCCUPIED or UNOCCUPIED property must maintain their lawns... heights cannot exceed 8 inches... or the City will mow and the property owner will be billed



CURBSIDE YARD DEBRIS PICKUP

LEAVES & TWIGS placed in biodegradable yard bags



STICKS & LIMBS placed going in the same direction and no longer than 4-feet long

As always, you may drop your yard waste in the bins across from DPW on the N Market/Jackson Curve
