

NOTICE OF ELECTION and REGISTRATION
City of Hudson, MICHIGAN
November 3, 2026 ELECTION

To the qualified electors of the City of Hudson:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the City of Hudson who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the City Clerk, the office of the County Clerk, a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is Monday, October 19, 2026.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.497) at the City Clerk's office, located at 121 N Church Street, Hudson MI 49247 at the following times:

- Regular business hours: Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.
- Saturday, October 31, 2026 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.
- Election Day, Tuesday, November 3, 2026 from 7 am to 8 pm.

Notice is hereby given that a general election will be held in the City of Hudson on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Absentee ballots are available for all elections; registered voters may contact the city clerk to obtain an application for an absent voter ballot or you may request to be placed on the permanent ballot list.

To comply with the Help America Vote Act (HAVA), voting instructions will be available in audio format and in Braille. Arrangements for obtaining the instructions in these alternative formats can be made by contacting the city clerk in advance of the election. All polling locations are accessible for voters with disabilities.
