## Garage Sale

### Hudson City-Wide August 4 - 7

- ◆ Permits are *free* and available at the City Office
- ◆ Permits are required and need to be posted
- ◆ Sales are limited to 3/year with 30 days between sales
- ◆ Max. duration is 7 consecutive days
- ◆ *City Wide* - NO Permit necessary and does NOT count as one of the 3/year
