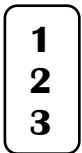

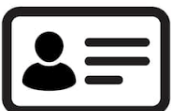

Garage Sale PERMITS

- ♦ Permits are *free* and available at the City Office
- ♦ Permits are required and need to be posted
- ♦ Sales are limited to 3 per year with 30 days between sales
- ♦ Maximum duration is 7 consecutive days
- ♦ *City Wide* - NO Permit necessary and does NOT count as one of the 3 per year

- ➔ A rate adjustment on your next Water Bill may be available for filling a pool.

Owners of OCCUPIED or UNOCCUPIED property must maintain their lawns. Grass, noxious weeds or other vegetation heights cannot exceed 8 inches.
