City of Hudson RESIDENTS



and persons who are **EMPLOYED WITHIN** the Hudson City Limits are required to file their

2023 CITY INCOME TAX RETURNS by MAY 1st

forms available online & at the City Office



2024 City-Wide Clean Up Saturday, APRIL 20th

All items must be curbside by 7am on this day, but no earlier than **SEVEN (7) DAYS** prior

Items need to be in BAGS or CONTAINERS & fill an area **NO LARGER THAN 4'x4'x4'**

Wood must have nails removed PANELING must be in 4'x4' pieces BOARDS need to be 4' long or less DRYWALL must be in containers & cannot weigh more than 50-pounds

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

auto parts cement batteries brick cinder blocks dirt tires stone mulch



Refuse pick-up is for CITY RESIDENTS ONLY.
A fine will be charged if rubbish from outside of the City is found being brought into the City.
