- Leaves raked to the curb -- **NOT** in the street
- **NO** twigs or branches -- they are **DANGEROUS** for the DPW Crew
- **NO** burning of leaves, twigs, or brush

**Leaves & Twigs** placed in biodegradable yard bags  
**Sticks & Limbs** placed going in the same direction and no longer than 5-feet long

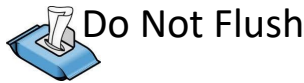
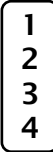

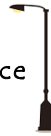
