The City of Hudson has partnered with U.S. EPA's Get the Lead Out (GLO) Initiative!

The GLO Initiative provides free technical assistance to accelerate the identification and plan for the removal of lead water service lines. The Hudson Department of Public Works will be teaming up with our partners at the GLO Initiative to visit neighborhoods throughout the City to conduct free water service line identifications. These identifications are free and take only 2 to 5 minutes! Staff members will ask to view your service line where it enters your home or business, usually in the basement or utility closet. Allowing our team to identify your service line material will help us complete a federally required water service line inventory and plan for the replacement of lead service lines. We appreciate your cooperation!
