FOR THE DOGS

- Dogs are not allowed to run freely and must be secured.
- Dogs should not be permitted to disturb the peace by frequent barking, howling, or yelping.
- Dogs are not permitted to discharge excrement upon any private or public property. Dog owners must remove excrement from these areas immediately upon discharge.
- Hudson has a 3 DOG LIMIT. It shall be unlawful to own or harbor more than 3 dogs (6-months or older) within the City limits.
- Dogs 6-months or older must have a current Dog License.



CODE OF ORDINANCES SEC 12-206. CURFEW




It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of 18 years of age to be in public areas, or other unsupervised places in the City between the hours of 10:00 pm and 6:00am the following morning, except of Friday and Saturday nights such prohibition for persons 16-17 years of age shall be 11:00pm and 6:00am the following morning.

This section does not apply to minors accompanied by a parent, guardian or another adult person having care and custody of the minor.



GARAGE SALE PERMITS

All garage, yard, basement, etc. sales must have a permit which will be posted in a conspicuous place at all times during the sale. Sales shall be limited to **3 per year** and not more than 7 consecutive days each with a minimum of 30 days between the last day and the first day of any sale. (Permits are NOT necessary for the City-Wide Garage Sale).

Permits are FREE and available at the City Office

Lawn Maintenance

Owners of OCCUPIED or UNOCCUPIED property must maintain their lawns. Grass, noxious weeds or other vegetation heights cannot exceed 8 inches.
