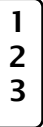

Rabies Certificate & Proof of Spay/Neuter Required



ALL DOGS MUST BE LICENSED



SNOW and ICE **MUST** be cleared from sidewalks no later than 12 hours after cessation. **DO NOT** deposit snow, ice, or slush onto the roadway.

Monthly Curbside Yard Debris Pickup MONDAY DECEMBER 2

Leaves & Twigs placed in biodegradable yard bags



Sticks & Limbs placed going in the same direction and no longer than 5-feet long



As always, you may drop your yard waste in the bins across from DPW on the N Market / Jackson curve



Weather & Emergency



Snowmobile Rules

- MAY NOT operate upon the land of another without their consent
- MAY NOT operate on the City Trails, within Maple Grove Cemetery, a public or private parking lot, or within 100 feet of a sledding area
- MAY NOT pass within 100 feet of a dwelling between midnight and 6am at greater than minimal speed

Stay to the EXTREME RIGHT of the Road
