Spring Rubbish Pick-Up Saturday, April 13th

All items must be curbside by 7am on this day,
but no earlier than **SEVEN (7) DAYS** prior.

Items that **WILL NOT** Be Picked Up Are:

Vehicle Tires Batteries
Fluorescent Bulbs Large Auto Parts
Bricks, Concrete, or Cement Blocks
Paint or Stain Cans, Liquids of any type
Refrigerators (without a CFC sticker & door removed)

If articles are placed at the curb **AFTER** your street has been picked up,
the crews **WILL NOT** return to that street. Any remaining items should
be removed from the curbside by 7am the following morning.

Refuse pick-up is for City of Hudson Residents only.
A fine will be charged if rubbish from outside of the City

GARAGE SALE PERMITS

All garage, yard, basement, etc. sales must have a permit which will be posted in a conspicuous place at all times during the sale. Sales shall be limited to **3 per year** and not more than 7 consecutive days each with a minimum of 30 days between the last day and the first day of any sale. *(Permits are NOT necessary for the City-Wide Garage Sale).* Permits are free and available at the City Office.

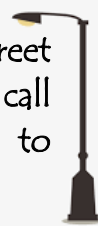

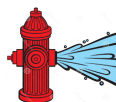

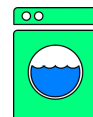

Spring Hydrant Flushing

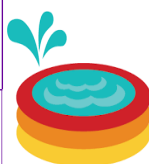

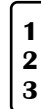
