GARAGE SALE PERMITS

All garage, yard, basement, etc. sales must have a permit which will be posted in a conspicuous place at all times during the sale. Sales shall be limited to **3 per year** and not more than 7 consecutive days each with a minimum of 30 days between the last day and the first day of any sale. (Permits are NOT necessary for the City-Wide Garage Sale). Permits are *free* and available at the City Office.




