Special Election on 911 Surcharge Tuesday, May 3, 2016

Residents of the City of Hudson will be voting at the fire station addition between the hours of 7:00 a.m. ó 8:00 p.m. Absentee ballots are available until Saturday, April 30, 2016 at the City Office. On Saturday the 30th the office will be open from 9:00 a.m. ó 2:00 p.m. in the event you need to request an absentee ballot. **The last day to register to vote in the May Special Election is April 4, 2016.** You may register at the Secretary of States Office, or by bringing your photo identification to the Hudson City Clerk's Office. Please keep in mind that prior to voting at the polls, you must be able to provide the election inspector proper photo identification. In most cases a driver's license will work. If you do not have a driver's license, please contact Jeaniene McClellan at (517) 448-8983 for additional types of approved photo identification.

City of Hudson Annual Spring Rubbish Pick-Up Saturday, April 16, 2016

City-Wide Clean-Up

All items for general pick-up must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. on this day but no earlier than **seven (7) days** before the pick-up date.

Items that **WILL NOT** be picked up on this day are:

- vehicle tires
- refrigerators (without a CFC sticker & door removed)
- batteries
- paint or stain cans, liquids of any type
- large auto parts
- fluorescent bulbs
- bricks, concrete, or cement blocks.

Please remember that if articles are placed at the curb after your street has been picked up, the crews will not return to that particular street, and items should be removed from the curbside by 7:00 a.m. the following morning. **Refuse pick-up is for City of Hudson residents only. A fine will be charged if rubbish from outside of the City is found being brought into the City.**

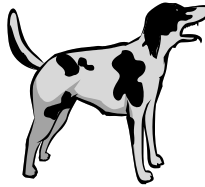

All Dogs Must Be Licensed:

Several complaints have been received concerning barking dogs, loose dogs, and other matters regarding dogs. Dog owners must be aware that dogs are not allowed to run freely and must be secured. Dogs should not be permitted to disturb the peace by frequent barking, howling, or yelping. Dogs are not permitted to discharge excrement upon any private or public property. Dog owners must remove excrement from these areas immediately upon discharge. Hudson has a 3 dog limit. It shall be unlawful to own or harbor more than 3 dogs, 6 months or older in the City limits. GARAGE SALE PERMITS

Ordinance No. 381.08.

Effective May 31, 2008, all garage, yard, basement, etc. sales must have a permit which will be posted in a conspicuous place at all times during the sale. Sales shall be limited to 3 per year and not more than 7 consecutive days each with a minimum of 30 days between the last day and the first day of any sale. Garage Sale permits are *free*. This does not pertain to the city wide garage sales. Please call the city office for more information.
