City-Wide Clean-Up

Fall clean-up is **Saturday, October 15th**. All items for general pick-up must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. on this day but no earlier than **seven (7) days before** the pick-up date.

Items that **CANNOT** be disposed of on this day are:

- vehicle tires
- refrigerators (without a CFC sticker & door removed)
- batteries
- paint or stain cans, liquids of any type
- large auto parts
- fluorescent bulbs
- bricks, concrete, or cement blocks.

Please remember that if articles are placed at the curb after your street has been picked up, the crews will not return to that particular street, and items should be removed from the curbside by 7:00 a.m. the following morning. **Refuse pick-up is for City of Hudson residents only. A fine will be charged if material from outside of the City is found being brought into the City.**

Snowmobiles stay off the trails and sidewalks

Everyone who has a sidewalk will have 12 hours to clear them of snow and ice after cessation. State of Michigan prohibits anyone to deposit any snow, ice, or slush onto any roadway or highway.

Reminder to the city residents: Regular Trash Collection is not allowed to sit at the curb before 6:00 p.m. on the night before trash pickup and trash cans must be removed from the curb by 6:00 p.m. the following day. There is an 8 bag limit of household trash only but bigger items like furniture and mattresses are for the fall and spring clean up only.

LEAF PICK-UP SCHEDULE

Leaves raked to the curb in your area will be picked up in accordance with the schedule. **Please keep the leaves out of the street.** Please, ***no twigs or branches*** should be mixed with the leaves, as it is hazardous to both man and machine. Once the schedule has been completed, areas will be revisited and picked up as time permits.
