REMINDER



Hudson City Residents and Persons who are employed within the Hudson City Limits Are required to file their 2016 City Income Tax Returns at the Hudson City Offices by April 30th.

All Dogs Must Be Licensed:

We have received several complaints concerning barking dogs, loose dogs, and other matters regarding dogs. Dog owners must be aware that dogs are not allowed to run freely and must be secured. Dogs should not be permitted to disturb the peace by frequent barking, howling, or yelping. Dogs are not permitted to discharge excrement upon any other's private or public property. Dog owners must remove excrement from these areas immediately upon discharge.



Hudson has a 3 dog limit. It shall be unlawful to own or harbor more than 3 dogs, 6 months or older in the City limits. All of the items mentioned above can be found in greater detail in the Hudson City Code. The Code is available on the City's website at www.ci.hudson.mi.us



Lawn Maintenance

Owners of occupied or unoccupied property must maintain their lawns. Grass, noxious weeds or other vegetation heights cannot exceed 8 inches. The City will mow the property and bill the property owner.



City—Wide Clean Up Annual Spring Rubbish Pick-Up Saturday, April 8, 2017

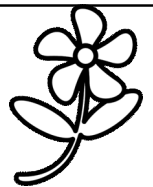
All items for general pick-up must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. on this day but no earlier than **seven (7) days** before the pick-up date.

Items that **WILL NOT** be taken are:

- vehicle tires
- refrigerators (without a CFC sticker & door removed)
- batteries
- paint or stain cans, liquids of any type
- large auto parts
- fluorescent bulbs
- bricks, concrete, or cement blocks.

Please remember that if articles are placed at the curb after your street has been picked up, the crews will not return to that particular street, and items should be removed from the curbside by 7:00 a.m. the following morning. **Refuse pick-up is for City of Hudson resi-**

GARAGE SALE PERMITS

Ordinance No. 381.08. Effective May 31, 2008, all garage, yard, basement, etc. sales must have a permit which will be posted in a conspicuous place at all times during the sale. Sales shall be limited to 3 per year and not more than 7 consecutive days each with a minimum of 30 days between the last day and the first day of any sale. Garage Sale permits are *free*. This does not pertain to the city wide garage sales. Please call the city office for more information.
